Respect in Sport helps us promote those values through a simple and convenient on-line training course for coaches and sport leaders. It is designed as a tool to assist coaches in identifying and dealing with abuse, dealing with abuse, neglect, harassment,

and bullying in sport.

The Respect in Sport program is a required course for all coaches. Consult your specific Provincial Sport Organization regarding deadlines for completing the course.

While the Respect in Sport course can take about 3 hours to complete. It is made up of several individual modules that can be completed one at a time.
