We all know that the Greendell Park Community Centre is the greatest community center in Manitoba, but some could argue that we're a little bias. Well now no one can argue that fact anymore. Not only do we think we're the best, but apparently the Wayne Gretzky Foundation as well as Hockey Canada think so too.

Last month's "Greendell Team of the Month" our own Peewee 12A1 hockey team recently received some exciting news. Hockey Canada named them as one of only 13 minor hockey teams nationwide as the beneficiaries of this year's 'Future Team Canada' program.



In December, Hockey Canada partnered with the Wayne Gretzky Foundation and the Hockey Canada Foundation to launch the fifth year of the 'Future Team Canada' program that rewards and recognizes minor hockey teams across the nation for the amount of heart they show rather than the amount of games they win.

Entries consisted of a team roster and a short essay outlining their team's values, special characteristics, community involvement and dedication that could make them a 'Future Team Canada'.

Every player on each of the 13 teams will receive a Team Canada jersey, stick and a hockey bag bearing the Wayne Gretzky Foundation and Hockey Canada logos. Along with this comprehensive equipment package, each team will also receive a \$1,999 cash award to be used for team development activities, and a coaching package consisting of development materials, a Hockey Canada Coaches' Club membership and equipment.



A spokes person for the team said they will be donating a large portion of the cash award to an inner city program that supplies hockey equipment to underprivileged boys and girls.

Congratulations to our Peewee 12A1 hockey team for being chosen by Hockey Canada and for making all Greendell Park members proud to be part of such a great community centre.
