Many Van Hull Estates families may be unaware

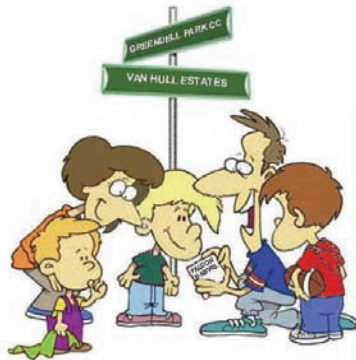
as to when and where they register for the upcoming winter season.
