- LATE FEE \$20.00 will be applied to ALL registrations after March 6, 2010.
- NO EXCEPTIONS. All late registrations must be done at the administration office. Late registrations WILL NOT be accepted after March 31, 2010 unless the sports convenor has verified an opening.

**BOOSTER/MEMBERSHIP FEE** is required for any sport or program.

Cost is \$50.00 per family per year -September 1, 2009 to August 31, 2010.
