GREENDELL VOLUNTEER OF THE YEAR

Presented by our member of the Manitoba Legislature, this award recognizes the contribution made by an individual to the Greendell Park Community Centre over a prolonged time frame and generally in more than one aspect of the programs and activities of the club.

CITY OF WINNIPEG AWARD

Present by our City of Winnipeg councillor, this award recognizes the outstanding contribution made by an individual to our Community Centre, as a long term volunteer, wherein his/her dedication enable programs and/or activities to continue to be viewed positively by participants and the community at large.

KEN HEIN MEMORIAL AWARD

In memory of Ken Hein, coach and member of our Greendell Park Community Centre, this award recognizes the volunteerism of teenagers and young adults. The recipient often combines education, part time work and their volunteer work. This dedication benefits the children of our community.

BENNY DNES COACHING AWARD

In memory of Benny Dnes, coach and member of our Greendell Park Community Centre, this award recognizes the role model value of the coach. The belief that teaching children the rules of the game, giving proper instruction and providing everyone on the team an equal opportunity to play, is the optimum role model.

Play It Again Sports "Community Commitment Program"

Play It Again Sports has announced it will run what it calls their "Community Commitment Program". The proposed program will provide both the customer, along with the customer's local community centre, with a 5% rebate on all purchases of a \$100.00 or more. Here is how the program will work.

For every \$100.00 spent at Play It Again Sports, customers will receive \$5.00 in "Sports Bucks". The customer can then use these "Sports Bucks" on a future visit, on anything they want. The "Sports Bucks" can accumulate spend \$500.00 and you'll receive \$25.00, spend more and you earn more "Sport Bucks".

When the customer is handed their "Sports Bucks" they will be asked which community centre they belong to. Play It Again Sports will match their amount of "Sports Bucks" in the form of a credit at that customer's home community centre. If the customer receives 50 "Sports Bucks" their community centre will be credited \$50.00 which can be used for future purchases at Play It Again Sports.

All club members, board members and club administrators will be able to view their club's running credit total on the Play It Again Sports website at www.playitagainsportswinnipeg.com.

Play It Again Sports stresses there are no strings attached to this program.

If our club were to earn a \$1,000.00 credit, we could use those funds, for example, to buy a new set of team jerseys absolutely free.

Play It Again Sports believes the success of their business is directly tied to healthy, busy community centres. They also believe that because they are a locally-owned company, they support those that have supported them since they first opened in 1991.
