Being Neighbourly

Recently the Manitoba Liquor Control Commission had received a few complaints from local area residents, regarding offensive activities that were taking place outside on the grounds of the community centre. Some of the activities were noise related, while others involved open liquor complaints. The one common complaint was all of these situations occurred outside on the grounds of the community centre while the facility was rented for private social functions. Upon further investigation most centered on the area directly in front of the main entrance, which is commonly used as the outdoor smoking area during social functions.

The MLCC had requested a meeting with the Greendell Park Community Centre at which time they brought these concerns to the attention of the board of directors. The board immediately instituted several new rules and regulations to ensure that the concerns of both the local area residents and the MLCC were dealt with in a timely and effective manner. An informational letter (a copy of which is printed on page 2) was drafted by the board and hand delivered to all the homes in the immediate vicinity of our community centre.

The revenue that our facility rentals generate, is the single largest revenue stream we self produce and the funds generated support many of the programs we provide to our membership. The monies raised from our facility rental goes directly towards the operational cost of our community centre.

The purpose of our community centre is to provide social and recreational services to our area residents, but we are more than just a service provider. To several area residents we are a close neighbour. To that end, we want to ensure that for those very special members we are considered a good neighbour.

We will continue to monitor all of the activities during social functions at our community centre and in order to validate the policy changes we have put into place to ensure have indeed corrected the situation and have dealt with concerns of our neighbours. We are also prepared to make any additional changes necessary, in order to eliminate these problems from occurring in the future.

Being neighbourly is a very important part of who we are and the feelings and concerns of our members are of the utmost importance to us.

Community Update

In an effort to be a better Community partner, Greendell Park Community Centre will be implementing the following changes to our hall rental policy for socials and events.

- "New smoking area for socials" - we will be working with MLCC to decide on a New Smoking area that will be away from the front entrance of the Community Centre. This will help to alleviate noise issues that could be disturbing to our immediate neighbours.
- "Serving it Safe Program" - we are making it mandatory that all people involved with running our socials (Supervisors and Servers) to take part in a certification program called "Serving it Safe". This program will enable us to improve the way we run events in our Community Centre where alcohol is served. This, in turn, should result in reduced alcohol related issues.
- "Security" - additional security will be added to assist the Social Supervisor. This added security will enable us to better monitor all exits of the facility to stop the transfer of alcohol outside of the facility during events. This added security will also help expedite and control the exit of patrons at the end of these events.

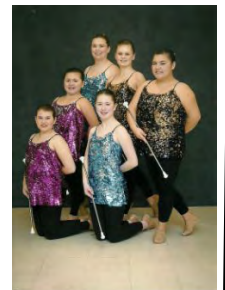
